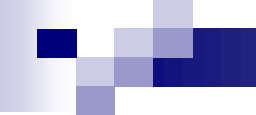


What is a **Social Network**?

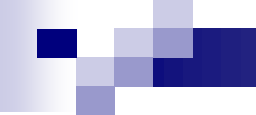
Research Networking

- Research Networking (RN) is about using **tools** to **identify**, **locate** and **use** research and scholarly information about **people** and **resources**.
- RN tools facilitate **collaboration** and **team** science to address research challenges through the rapid discovery and recommendation of researchers, expertise and resources.



Why is Network Research Important?

- Strong networks provide a range of benefits including **learning, sources of information, salary growth, innovation** and a means of getting things done.
- Research shows that **people with diverse contacts are able to access information that helps them generate better ideas.**



Research Networking

- Research Networking are web-based tools to **organize, discover, disseminate**, making **visible** the research and scholarly information to be used by **researchers & scientist**.
- They are a large variety of tools for **researcher profiles, knowledge sharing & output dissemination**.
- Research Networking tools serve as **knowledge management systems** for the research enterprise.

Research Networking

- Research Networking tools connect institution-level/enterprise systems, national research networks, publicly available research data (e.g., grants and publications), and restricted/proprietary data by harvesting information from disparate sources into compiled expertise profiles for faculty, investigators, scholars, clinicians, community partners, and facilities.



Research Networking

- Research Networking tools facilitate the development of **new collaborations** and **team science** to address new or existing research challenges through the rapid discovery and **recommendation** of **researchers**, **expertise**, and resources.

Research Networking

- Research Networking tools are different from search engines such as **Google** & also **social networks** such as **Facebook** as they represent a cleaned organized data ingested from authoritative and verifiable sources rather than predominantly individually asserted information, making.



Research Networking

- RN tools also generally have associated **analytical capabilities** that enable **evaluation** of **collaboration** and **cross-disciplinary research/scholarly activity**, especially over time.

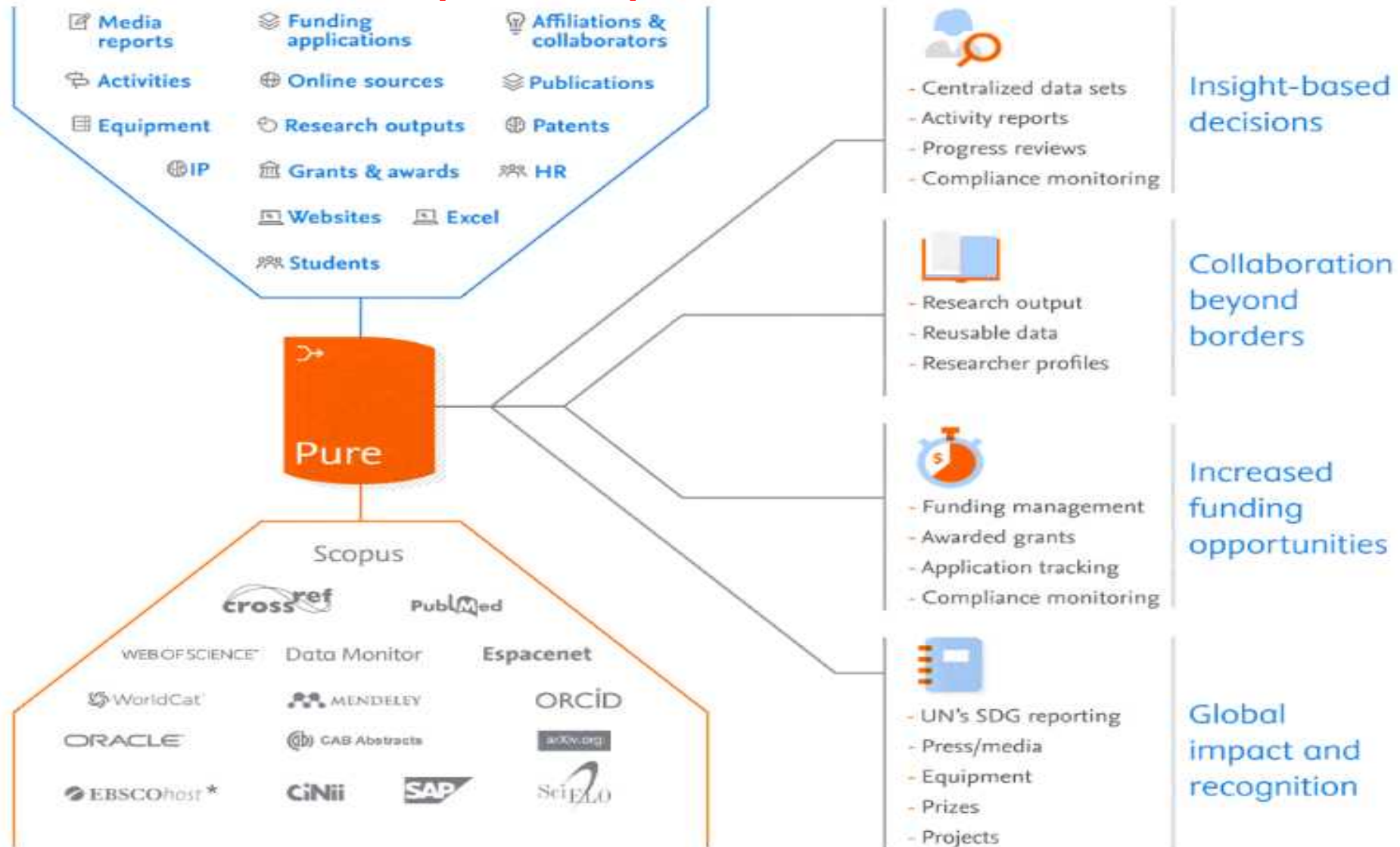

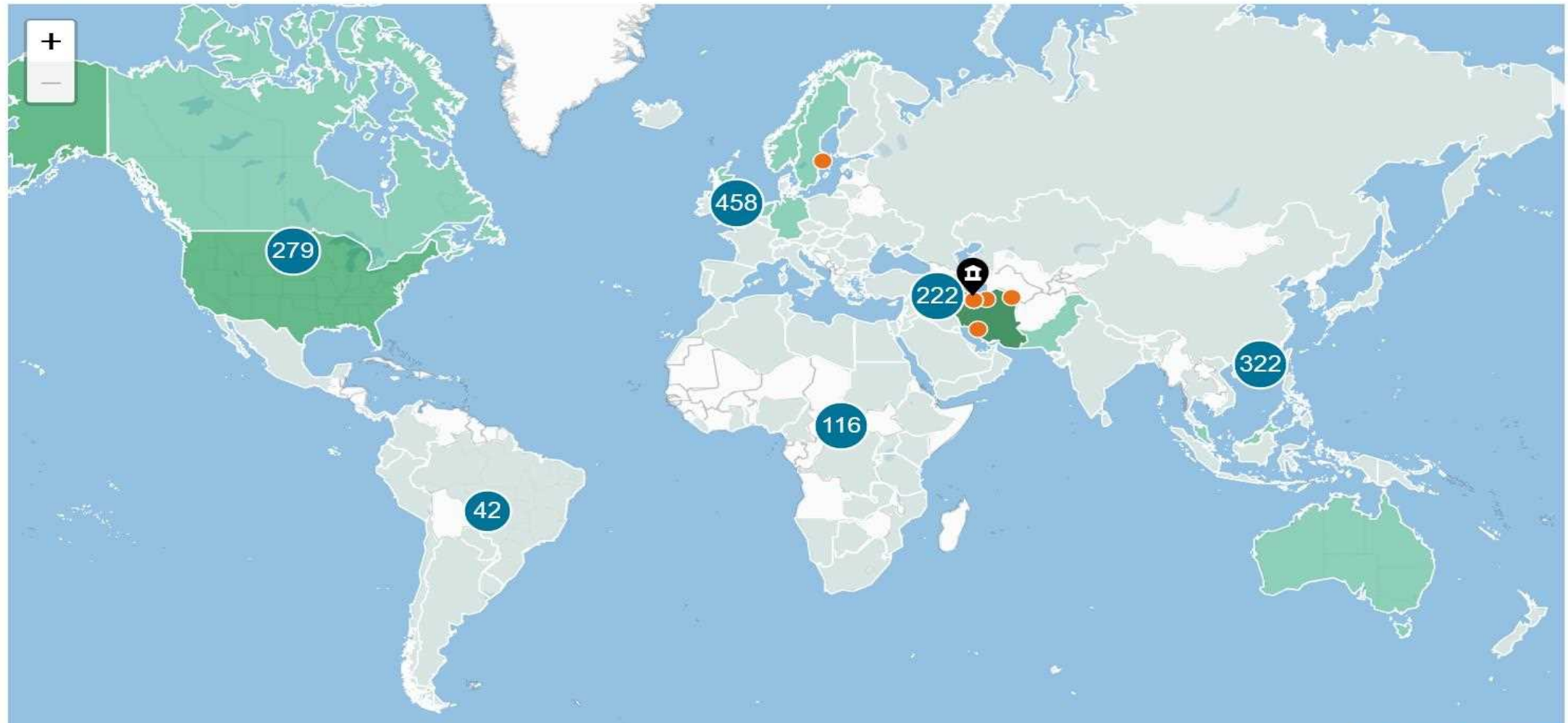

Co-authored publications per country/region:



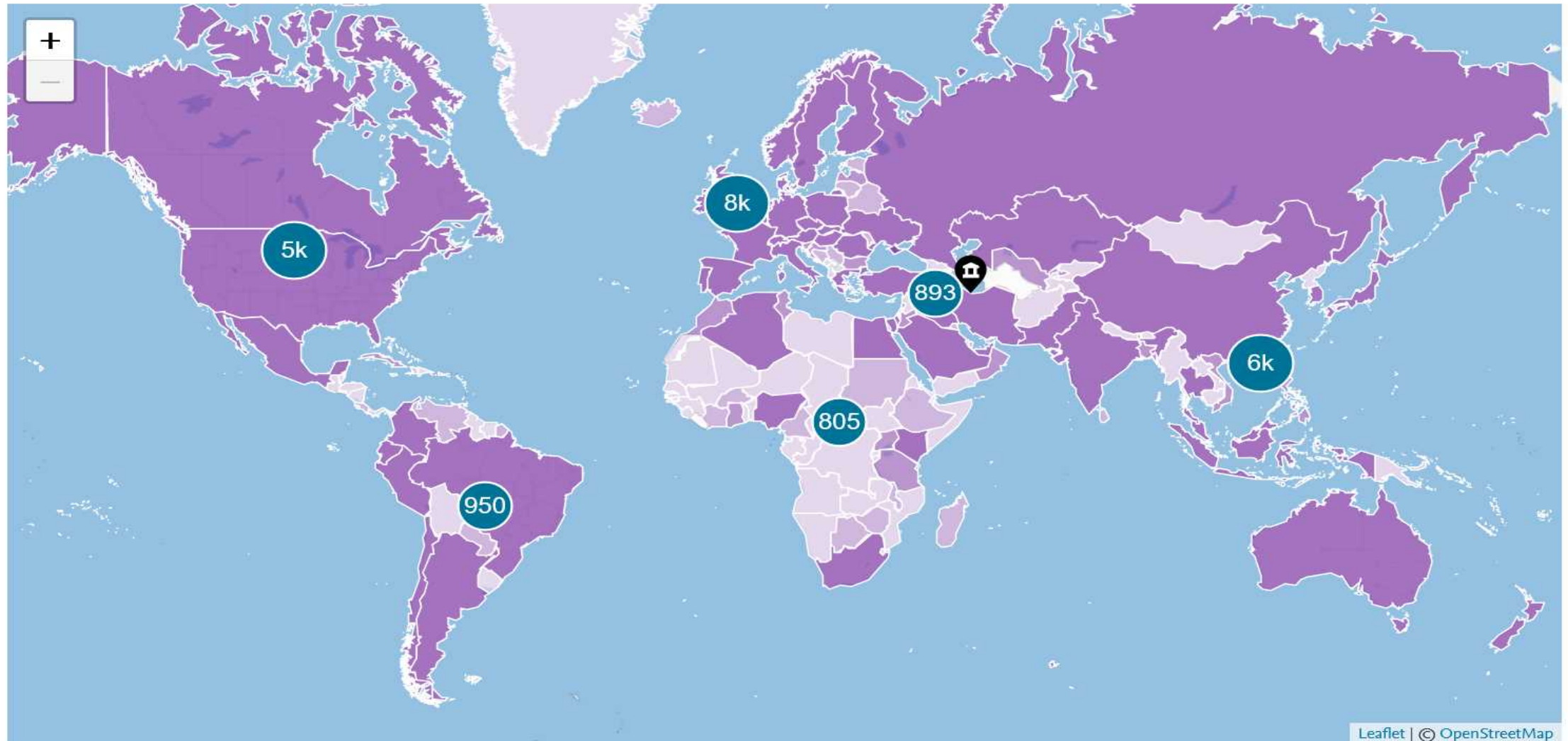

● Top 10 Institutions worldwide by co-authored publications



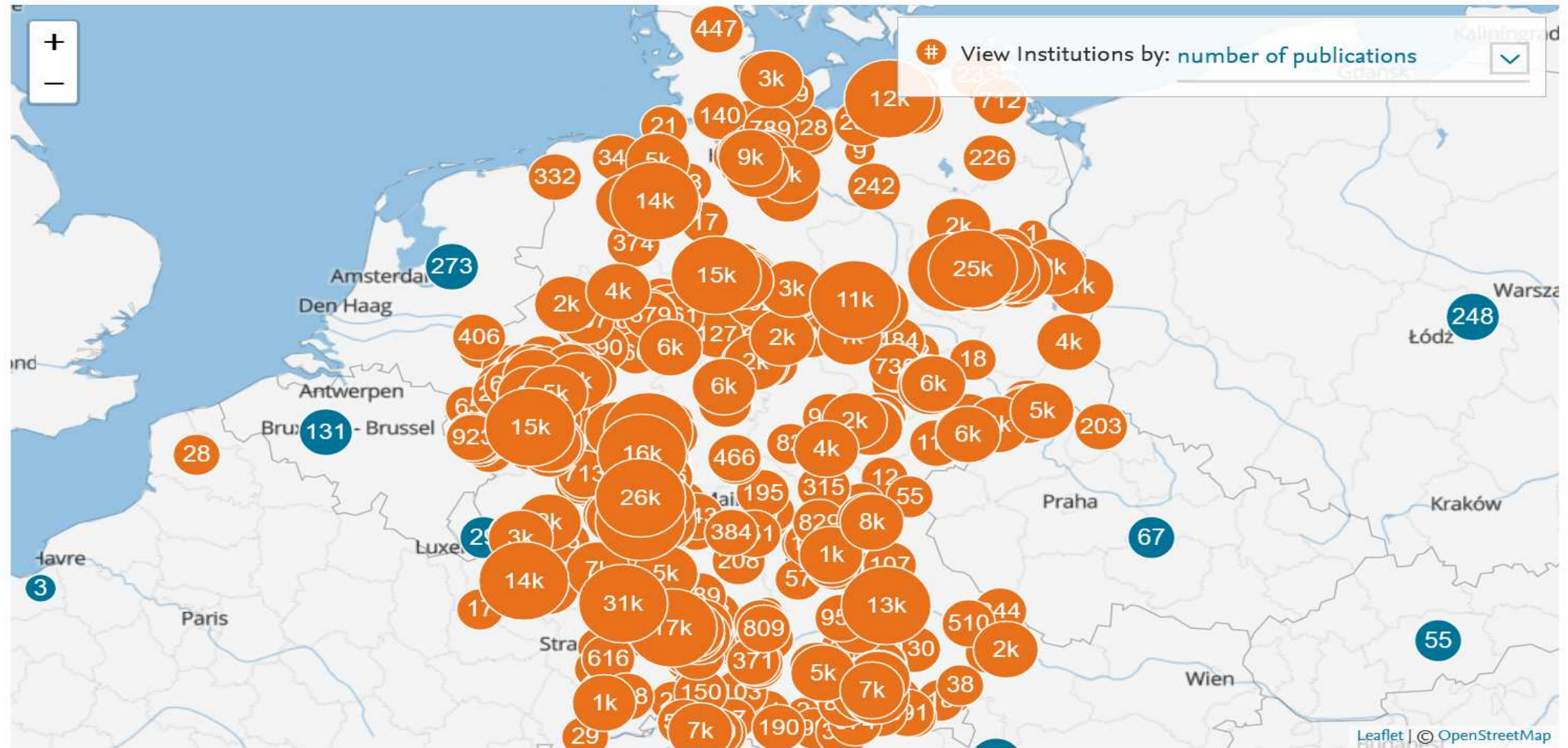

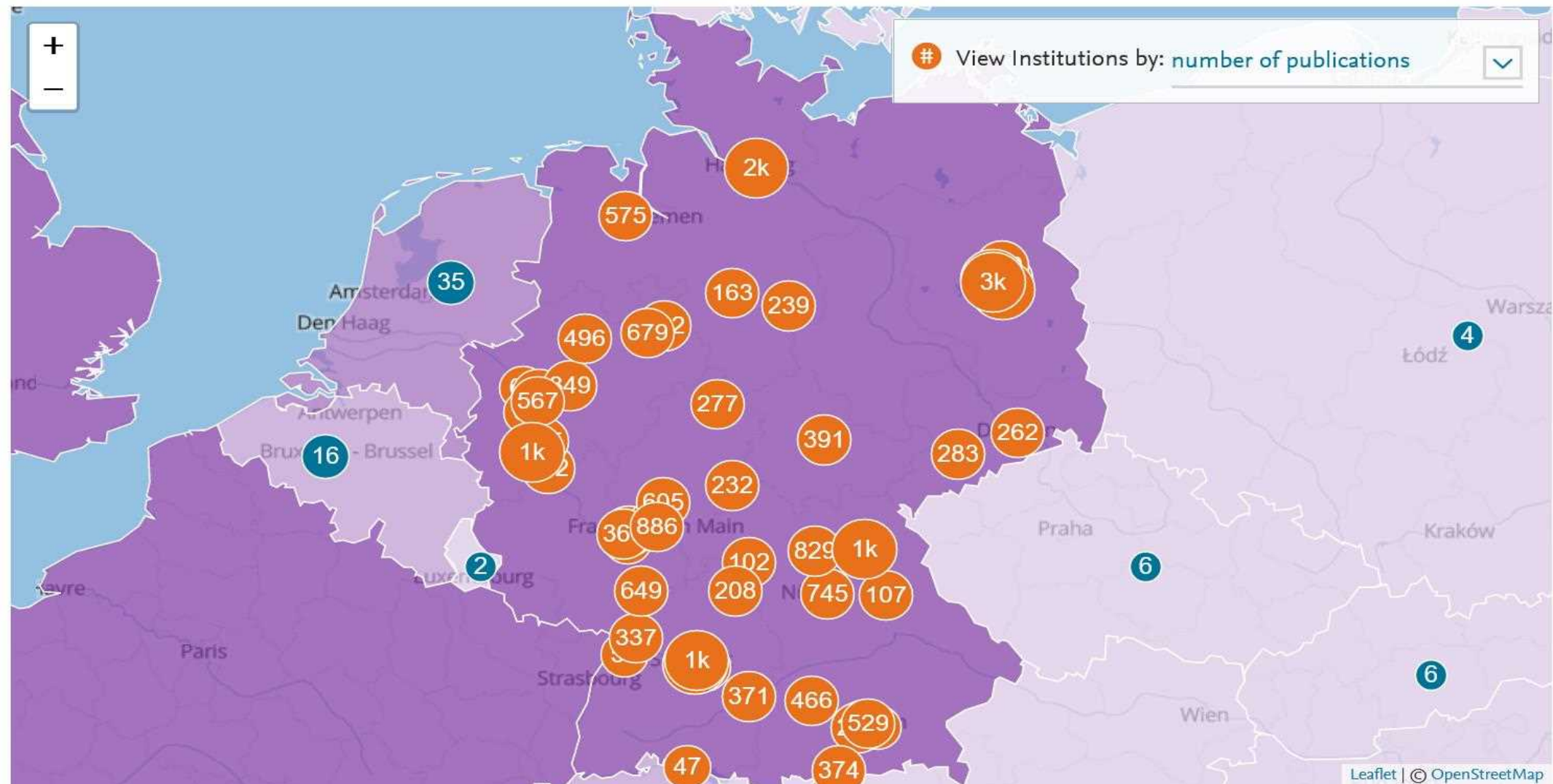

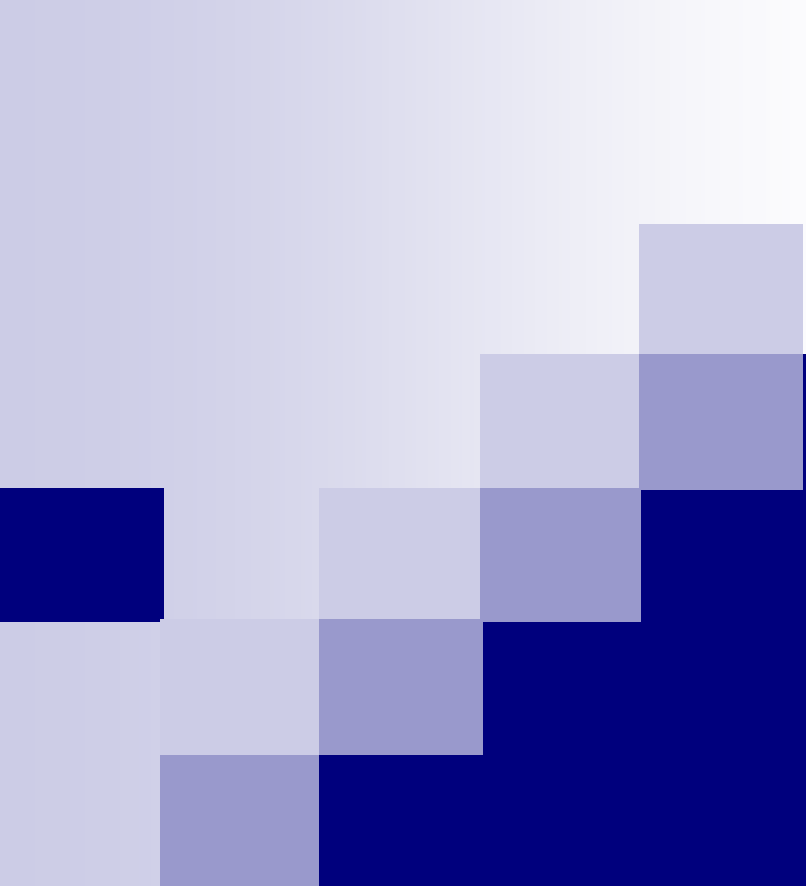
